



Since Medical Aid in Dying (MAiD) was legalized in 2016, more than 21,500 Canadians have chosen assisted suicide to end their lives.

While we often assume that people choose MAiD because of physical pain and suffering, the truth is that the most common reasons given are loss of ability to engage in meaningful life activities and loss of ability to perform activities of daily life. Pain is not the primary reason people choose MAiD.

But there is hope!

Because so many people are choosing MAiD for reasons that can be overcome with a culture of caring, Life's Vision is starting an initiative called Care Together. Care Together will be equip volunteers to connect with those that are isolated and lonely and will teach people what it means to care for those who are vulnerable. It will also advocate for better access to palliative care.

Each one of us can make a difference for life, when we care for the vulnerable in our families and communities.

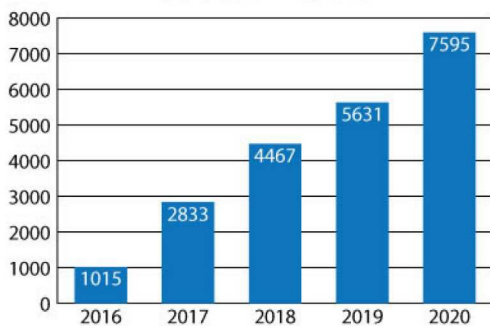

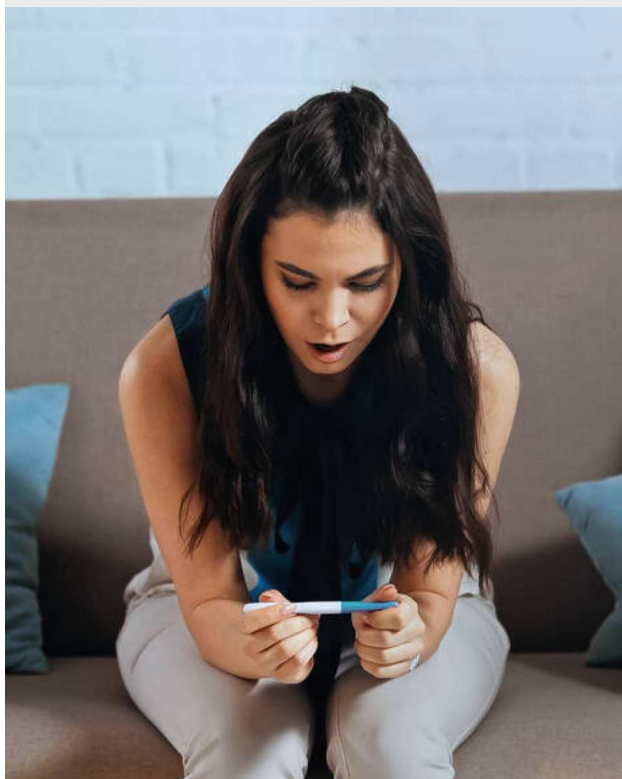


Angel Baby is here!

Helping Women in Crisis



We recently had the privilege of helping another pregnant teen. She found out she was pregnant at her school clinic when she went in for acne medication.

Before she left the clinic, the healthcare provider handed her a card that had an appointment for an abortion on it. She received no counselling and there was no discussion of her options. Just a card with an appointment to end the life of her baby.

Fortunately she cancelled that appointment and is expecting a baby boy in December. Life's Vision helped her find a safe place to stay and will be helping her with rent until her government benefits begin after her son is born.
