HOPE'S CRADLE TESTIMONY

We recently received a message from someone who was deeply impacted by the Hope's Cradle that Life Culture funded:

"Our family recently moved to this area (Southern Manitoba) from another province, and I had informed my mom about Hope's Cradle in Landmark's fire station.

When my mom came to visit a few weeks ago, we were walking down the sidewalk when she spotted the Hope's Cradle door. She went to the door, read the instructions on it, and cried.

Then she told me the story about her father and my grandfather. He had been surrendered at a safe place for babies and children when he was an infant. Since no relatives wanted the baby, his mother surrendered him.

My mom is so thankful that Taché Fire Department is that safe place in this community because she knows that if there hadn't been a surrender site for her father, she wouldn't be alive today."

THE YEAR IN A GLANCE

- Over 12,000 of our Give Care, Not MAiD postcards were ordered to be sent to key federal government ministers.
- Over 700 people attended our Walk for Life, braving extreme heat to support life. Hundreds of baby items were donated.
- Over 40 pastors attended our Pastors' Lunch 2023.
- We raised \$20,000 to fund the installation of a Hope's Cradle at the Landmark Fire Station in the RM of Taché.
- We gave a \$2,500 MPower scholarship to an 18 year-old single mom who is attending university to become a nurse.
- We helped dozens of single moms with things like diapers, groceries, gas, and rent.
- We started a foster mom peer support group to help and encourage foster moms.
- Angel Baby held it's first annual Walk to Remember in honour of babies lost during pregnancy and infancy.

It has been an incredibly productive year for Life Culture and we look forward to more in 2024!
